Riverfront project topic of Appleton meeting

APPLETON – The public is invited to a meeting Tuesday on a construction project planned next summer at a riverfront property below the College Avenue bridge.

The meeting gets under way at 5:30 p.m. at Telulah Park's pavilion, 1300 E. Newberry St., and will be facilitated by Tanesay Development.

The Colorado firm, which specializes in redeveloping contaminated property, is buying 15 acres for \$2.2 million from the municipally owned Kaukauna Utilities.

Its RiverHeath project stretches from Banta Court to Telulah Park.
